RESOLUTION C — Hope Services 1.5 mill Renewal Levy for the necessity and for certification. The motion was made by Mr. Mires, seconded by Mr. Hastedt. Motion was not approved, by all three Commissioners.


RESOLUTION D — Approve Change Order in the amount of \$89,368.03 for Courthouse Tower Project. The motion was made by Mr. Mires, seconded by Mr. Hastedt. Motion approved unanimously.


9:47 a.m. — Steve Tucker, Hope Services- 1.2 mill Renewal Levy. The request for a 1.5 renewal levy from Hope Services was not supported by the Henry County Commissioners due to an Eleven (11) million dollar carry over. The Commissioners feel there is not a necessity currently.

10:15 a.m. — Judge Rosebrook, Judge McColley and Kevin Garringer- Indigent Defense. The Office of the Ohio Public Defender sent out a memo announcing Governor Dewine and the Ohio General Assembly have allocated approximately \$336 million dollars in the Biennial State Budget to reimburse counties for indigent defense costs for fiscal years 22-23. Discussion was also held on the possible recoupment from the clients who receive indigent defense.
