From Toledo: Take SR 24 West. Turn left onto SR 109. Turn right onto Co. Rd. M. Turn left onto Co. Rd. 11.

From Fulton Co: Take SR 108 South through Napoleon. Turn left onto Co. Rd. M. Turn right onto Co. Rd. 11. OR Take SR 109 South. Turn right onto Co. Rd. M. Turn left onto Co. Rd. 11.

Municipal Waste

CASH, CHECK, OR DEBIT/CREDIT CARDS

(Cards subject to \$2.00 or 3.15% fee,
whichever is greater)

\$120.00/Ton up to 1500 lbs - Prorated
\$144.00/Ton - over 1501 lbs - Prorated
\$15.00 Minimum - up to 200 pounds
\$10.00 Fee - uncovered loads

The following items are accepted at municipal waste rate (some additional fees may apply) but must be unloaded at designated area or container for recycling purposes. Notify scale operator of any of the following items at time of check in:

- **Mattress:** \$12.00/each
- **Freon Appliance:** \$12.00/each
- **Paint:** May be disposed in waste container if dry or thickened.
- **Clean Metals:** Container south of waste container. Examples - bicycles, non-freon appliances, grills, fencing, pipes, etc.
- **Electronics:** Box at each end of waste container. All items with a power cord supply.
- **Aluminum Cans:** Mighty tidy at west end of waste container.
- **Batteries:** Pallet at each end of waste container.
- **Motor Oil:** Ask for local disposal centers.

General Public Rates:
\$.15/LB - CLEAN* Tires, all types, including
Out of County

Licensed Tire Transporter Rates:
\$.15/LB - CLEAN* Tires

Please follow these guidelines when bringing in clean (no dirt, mud, debris)* tires:

Upon arrival, notify scale operator with tire type and county of origin. Tires do not need to be covered.

Earthmoving tires will not be accepted.

EPA Guidelines only allow 10 tires per load. Contact a licensed tire transporter for hauling more than 10 tires.

Passenger Tire Equivalent (PTE) equals 25 pounds per tire.

Delivery of tires cannot include any municipal waste.

Final inspection of tires will be made at the unloading area.

\$15.00 Minimum - up to 500 pounds
\$10.00 Fee - uncovered loads

Please follow these guidelines when bringing yard waste:

Notify scale operator with loads of yard waste at time of check in.

Delivery of yard waste cannot include any municipal waste. Should there be any other waste found, the load will be adjusted at the scale house and charged at waste rates.

All haulers are responsible for loading any garbage or other debris left at the unloading area.

Final inspection of loads will be made at the unloading area.
